

Parent/Student Contract

General Practice Information

- Practices are at East Ridge and they run from **January 2nd 2018 to March 21st 2018**. A detailed play calendar will be available after casting is complete.
- Practices are mandatory and we ask that appointments be scheduled for days that practice doesn't occur.
- If there is no school, there is no practice.
- Students who are not in attendance for the school day may not return to school for practice. We understand that illnesses will happen and we will discuss continuing in the play on a case by case basis if there are successive absences due to illness.
- Dress rehearsal will be at Woodinville High School Theater on March 22nd. The performances will be Friday, March 23rd, 7pm and Saturday, March 24th, 11:00am & 3:00pm at WHS theater.

Cast Members: Cast members practice one day a week. Which day a child has practice is determined by the role in which they are cast. **Practice days are: Tuesdays 3:40-5:15 or Wednesdays 2:15-4:30 or Fridays 3:40-5:15**. Specific day assignments will be handed out along with the casting results in the first week of December.

Stage and Teach team: Stage crew consists of 10 fourth or fifth graders. Practices are Wednesdays beginning in **February through Tech Week**.

Mandatory Cast, Stage Crew, & Parent Meeting will be held Friday, December 8th

- All hands meeting 3:40-4:00pm. During this time, the actor book (containing script and score) will be handed out to each cast member. (Room location tbd)
- 4:00-5:00pm:
 - Students will be in one room doing a full read through of the musical.
 - Parents will be in another going over all necessary information they will need to know for rehearsals, production, and volunteering.

This behavioral contract, signed by BOTH the child and parent/guardian and a check made out to ERPTA for the appropriate amount must be turned into the front office of East Ridge Elementary **NO LATER THAN end of day on Wednesday, November 1st**. Failure to turn in the necessary documents and participation fee will result in the loss of the child's spot in the play. Fees are non-refundable.

For We Are Monsters to succeed, participants/parents must want to participate and abide by the following rules:

I therefore agree:

1. I want to participate in We Are Monsters.
2. I will be respectful of the show staff, fellow actors, student volunteers, and parent volunteers.
3. I will show consideration for others by using an appropriate voice level and by listening and using respectful language and gestures.
4. I will show pride in our school by keeping the school grounds, library, and classrooms free of litter and taking good care of the building.
5. I will protect and care for the props, costumes, and sets.
6. I will not touch or disturb anything in the donated gym, stage, classroom spaces, etc.
7. I will build others "up" and not "down". I will not use put downs, gossip or exclude other. I understand that the East Ridge Musical has a zero-tolerance policy for bullying.
8. I will eat snacks in the outside under the covered area of the school. I will not eat snacks in any foyers, the gym, stage, or library.
9. I will be at musical rehearsals for my assigned times and every day of tech week until my dismissal time.

If I disregard one of the above rules, I know the following steps will be taken:

1. I will be asked to not engage in the inappropriate behavior by a parent or student volunteer who will then place my name on a list in the gym that will be reviewed at the end of each day by a member of the musical's leadership.
2. If my name is placed on the list twice in one day, I will be asked to leave rehearsal and not interact with others for a temporary time period.
3. If my name is placed on the list three times in one day, I will lose the privilege of participating in rehearsal for the remainder of that day. Someone will be contacted to pick me up from school or I will wait quietly until I am picked up at the end of rehearsal.
4. Should I lose the privilege of full participation two times (see number 3), I will not be invited back to the ERPTA Musical for any remaining rehearsals. Should this happen, no money will be refunded.
